BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, _____
of _____, in the County of _____,
State of Montana, as Principal, and

_____, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of _____,
and having its principal place of business in the City of _____, State of _____,
and licensed to do business under the laws of the State of Montana, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Montana, for the use
and benefit of the Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife, & Parks in the penal sum of \$ _____,
lawful money of the United States of America, for the payment of which, well and truly to made, said Principal binds himself, his
heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns; and said Surety binds itself, its heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, jointly and
severally firmly by these presents.

WHEREAS, the above-named Principal has been duly appointed as a license agent to sell state hunting and fishing
licenses and permits and certificates prescribed by the Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife, & Parks, as provided for in Title 87, Part 9
(Sections 87-2-910, et seq.) of the Montana Code Annotated.

NOW THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is that if Principal and all agents and employees of the Principal
shall faithfully perform all of the duties imposed on Principal, as said license agent, and if they shall timely account for and timely pay to
the Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife, & Parks all money received from the sale of hunting and fishing licenses and any permits or
certificates all as prescribed and as required by laws and rules of the department, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise, it
shall be in full force and effect.

FURTHERMORE, the above-named Surety shall have the right to terminate any future liability hereunder by serving
written notice of election so to do upon the Principal and upon the Director, Montana Department of Fish, Wildlife, & Parks, and
thereupon the said Surety shall be discharged from any future liability hereunder for any default of said Principal occurring after the
expiration of 30 days from and after the service of such notice.

The surety may cancel this bond as to future liability by giving thirty (30) days written notice by registered mail
addressed to the Principal at the address in this bond stated, and to the Director, Department of Fish, Wildlife, & Parks. If the Principal
does not execute and have approved a new bond prior to the effective date of such cancellation by the surety, his dealership will be
automatically suspended by operation of law and Principal shall immediately return all unsold licenses, all copies of previously sold
licenses, and supplies pertaining to the selling of fishing and hunting licenses. If at any time during the term hereof, the Principal
furnishes a new bond accepted by the Director, Department of Fish, Wildlife, & Parks, this bond shall be canceled as of the date of said
approval. The surety shall remain liable, however, subject to all the terms, conditions, and provisions of this bond, for any and all acts
covered by this bond up to the date of such cancellation.
